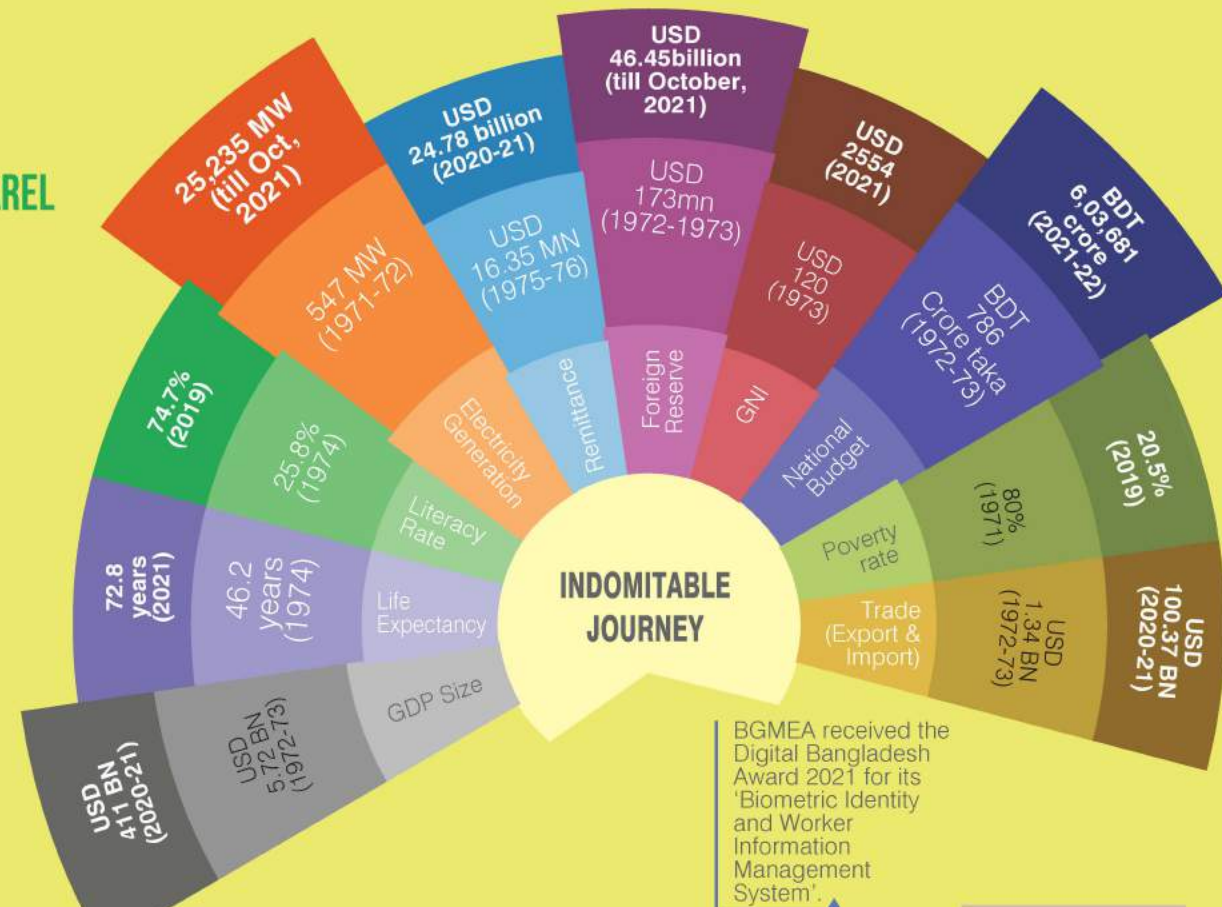

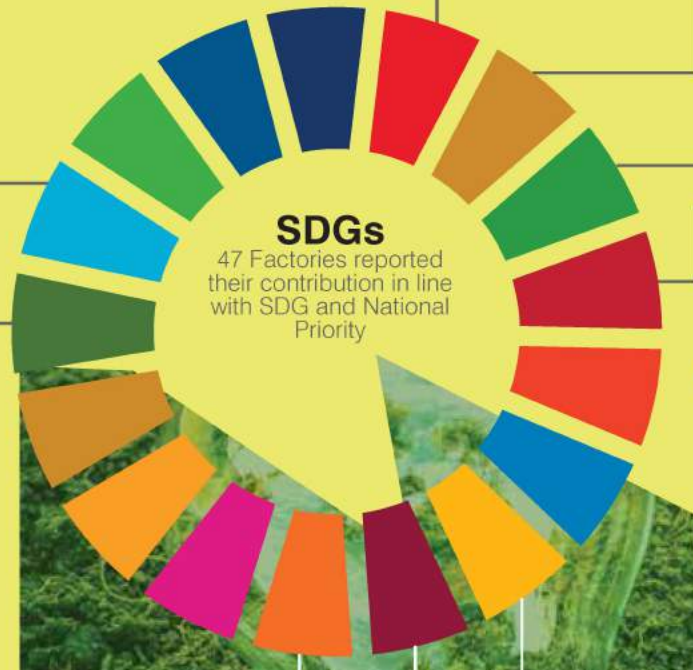

Embracing 4IR and wage digitisation

85% workers have homestead land, 47% have a house, 53% have agricultural land, 66% have electrical or electronic gadgets in their house and 15% have shops and other assets.
